Application

Eligible individuals are spouses and children of active duty, reserve, or retired active duty military (officer or enlisted) or DOD Civilian that will be enrolled in a full or part-time accredited degree program during the upcoming 2012-2013 academic year. Applicants or their sponsors must reside in or be assigned to Hawaii and be a member in good standing of the Hui O' Wahine. Individuals who will be attending a service academy or who accept any other full scholarship are not eligible to apply for this scholarship. Scholarships are based on scholastic merit and community involvement. Race, color, sex, national origin, or financial need will not influence the selection.

Applications and transcripts must be completed and postmarked no later than 31 March 2012. Transcripts are to be sent by the school(s), **in a sealed envelope**, directly to the Hui O' Wahine (Hui) Scholarship Committee. **Schools** must send transcripts (with grades), in a sealed envelope. Standardized test scores (SAT, ACT) should also be sent by the school. These scores are only necessary for high school seniors. For applicants not currently in school, transcripts from the most recent school(s) attended must be sent. Applicant is responsible for making sure transcripts are received by the Hui Scholarship Committee. An application is not considered complete without transcripts; late or incomplete applications will not be considered (See last page for checklist). Applications must be typewritten or written legibly in blue or black ink. If there is insufficient space for any question, please attach additional pages, labeled accordingly. All information must be documented on the Hui O' Wahine application. Resumes or curriculum vitae cannot be used as a substitute.

Awardees' will be notified in writing of their selection to receive a monetary award. Awardees' and their sponsors will be asked to sign a pledge affirming that they meet the eligibility requirements as stated herein. Awards will be made in the form of a check to the individual awardees' institution, contingent upon receipt by the Hui Scholarship Committee of a true copy of verification of enrollment in an accredited institution of higher learning. Several scholarships will be awarded. The use of scholarship monies awarded is restricted to payment of tuition, fees, books, and room and board.
